Management By Culture

In the world and in Vietnam, businesses are increasingly focusing on building culture as one of the essential goals in management and development strategies. Moreover, corporate culture is a core factor in attracting and retaining talents, directly impacting the business results of an organization. Research also indicates that organizations with powerful cultures achieve better business performance. Specifically, they show a capability to increase revenue by over 48%, enhance employee engagement by more than 80%, and improve customer satisfaction by more than 89% compared to organizations that pay less attention to culture and organizational culture (according to the Katzenbach Center).

Based on in-depth research, the **Management by Culture** program (**MBC** program) is a special program designed and delivered by **PACE Institute of Management** (PACE).
